PSST FINANCIAL REPORT:

Chief Muenz presented the cumulative reports regarding The Public Safety Sales Tax monthly financial statement for months ending of February 28, 2022 and March 31, 2022

The 1/2% Public Safety sales tax is imposed on all taxable goods and services within the City limits of Blue Springs and can only be used for public safety purposes. The tax went into effect on October 1, 2011. The detailed budget for the Public Safety Sales Tax Fund can be found on page 77 of the 2021-22 adopted budget. For the month of February, the City received 126% budgeted revenues and 108% of revenue received last year. For the fiscal year, PSST sales tax revenues are \$192,107 or 12% over budget.

The 1/2% Public Safety sales tax is imposed on all taxable goods and services within the City limits of Blue Springs and can only be used for public safety purposes. The tax went into effect on October 1, 2011. The detailed budget for the Public Safety Sales Tax Fund can be found on page 77 of the 2021-22 adopted budget. For the month of March, the City received 96% budgeted revenues and 99% of revenue received last year. For the fiscal year, PSST sales tax revenues are \$176,930 or 8.8% over budget.

Board members had discussion regarding financials and approved purchases. Chief and Board spoke about requested items and budget submitted. Board member Welchert moved to approve the PSST Financial reports. Motion seconded by Board member Stacer and carried with the following votes:


