**PSST FINANCIAL REPORT:**

Chief Muenz presented the cumulative reports regarding The Public Safety Sales Tax monthly financial statement for months ending April 30, 2022

“The 1/2% Public Safety sales tax is imposed on all taxable goods and services within the City limits of Blue Springs and can only be used for public safety purposes. The tax went into effect on October 1, 2011. The detailed budget for the Public Safety Sales Tax Fund can be found on page 77 of the 2021-22 adopted budget. For the month of April, the City received 103% budgeted revenues

and 100% of revenue received last year. For the fiscal year, PSST sales tax revenues are \$185,7117 or 8.0% over budget.”
