BEHAVIOR POLICY AND CONTRACT

We want Blue Springs Summer Day Camp to be a fun, safe and stimulating environment for **everyone**. In order to help us achieve this, it is important that both you and your camper read and understand the Behavior Policy and agree to following rules by signing at the bottom of this page. Please help your child understand their responsibilities for both themselves and towards others while attending Summer Day Camp. Thank you!

We recognize that it's not always easy for campers to make positive choices and sometimes they don't know the right choice. It is in these instances that campers require guidance in making the right, positive choice. This is where our behavior plan is put into place.

For small behavior issues, children will be given reminders and have talks with their counselor about appropriate behavior. If these behavior issues continue to reoccur, or if the behavior warrants more than a chat, a form will be filled out.

Blue Springs Day Camp operates under a 4 write up rule. Campers who misbehave or break camp rules will be given 4 chances leading up to dismissal from Blue Springs Day Camp without refund. **We reserve the right to bypass one or more steps in this process if a situation warrants it.**

1. I will show respect to other campers and treat them as well as I would like to be treated.
2. I will show respect to staff and cooperate with their instructions.
3. I will not verbally abuse others by using inappropriate language, gossip, threats, teasing, exclusion or harassment.
4. I will respect the environment by refraining from littering, vandalizing, stealing or abusing equipment that does not belong to me.
5. I will not deliberately cause bodily harm to other campers or staff. I understand that kicking, punching, hitting, biting, spitting, or fighting are not acceptable forms of behavior and will not be tolerated.
6. I will respect the property of other campers and staff.
7. I will be a positive contributor and will participate in all camp programs and activities.
8. I understand and agree that I am not allowed electronic devices that facilitate playing games, watching shows, or used as a phone for calling/texting. In event that I bring an electronic device to camp it will be held in the Recreation Supervisors office until the end of the day.
9. I understand that should the Camp Administration feel as though m behavior or actions may cause harm to myself or others, I may not be permitted to attend Blue Springs Summer Day Camp for the remainder of the summer.
10. I understand that these rules and guidelines are for the safety and the protection of myself and all campers and staff.

BEHAVIOR POLICY AND CONTRACT

1st write up: Camp Manager will call parent/guardian or talk to them upon pickup that day.

2nd write up: Camp Manager and Recreation Supervisor will discuss behavior modifications with the parent/guardian.

3rd write up: 3 day suspension from camp without refund.

4th write up: Dismissal from camp for 1 year.

Minor Behavior Issues examples:

- Following camp rules
- Being respectful
- Being safe
- Listening
- Making good decisions
- Following directions
- Being Cooperative
- Keeping hands, feet and all other objects to yourself (KHFOOTY)

Large Behavior Issues examples:

- Verbal abuse towards self, other campers or staff
- Behavior requiring constant 1 on 1 intervention
- Damage to program location/building or property
- Damage to the property of others
- Physical abuse towards self, other campers or staff.
